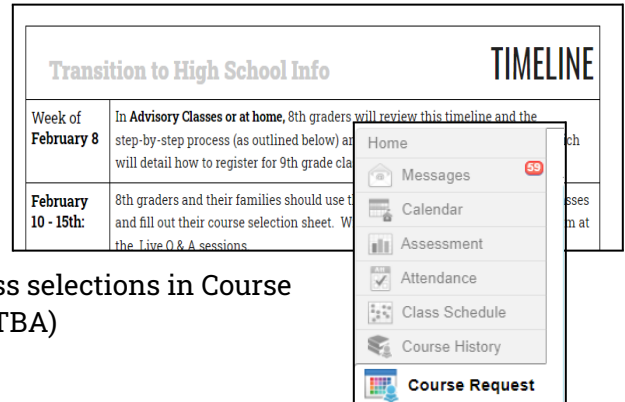

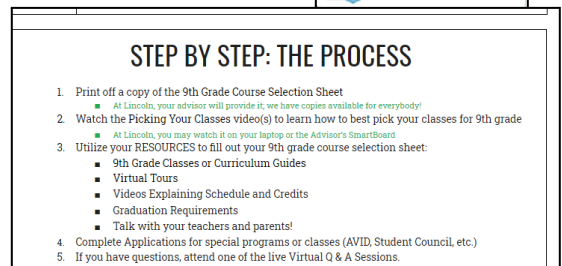
- Registration Timeline** Each High School is following a very similar timeline.

- Jan 20** : Get Registration Info
- Ongoing**: Many Q & A sessions are scheduled; they want to answer any questions you have!
- Anytime before 1/31**: Students input their class selections in Course Request, in Student Vue. (Poudre’s window (TBA))
