The purpose of today's message is to share information about 2 things: Food and Academics.

Food Information

Grab and Go lunch is provided at the following locations with more locations to be added soon:

11 to 11:30 a.m. at Laurel Elementary School, 1000 E. Locust Court, Fort Collins, CO 80524

11:45 a.m. to 12:15 p.m. at Beattie Elementary School, 3000 Meadowlark Ave., Fort Collins, CO 80526

12:30 to 1 p.m. at Bauder Elementary School, 2345 W. Prospect Road, Fort Collins, CO 80526

During the closure, the Food Bank for Larimer County will distribute food from two locations: 1301 Blue Spruce Drive, Fort Collins; and 2600 N. Lincoln Ave., Loveland. Their website is:

Beginning on March 31st, Mill City church in conjunction with Lincoln staff will deliver a late breakfast to the following communities at approximately 10:00 a.m. every Tuesday and Friday during the closure : Poudre Valley Mobile Home Park, Hickory, and 401 North Timberline, and Bull Run. We will pull in and honk our horns around 10. Students should come out and grab a nutritious breakfast in a to-go bag.

Academic Information
